Navigating the Dashboard

At the top of the dashboard, you'll find four main tabs. Click on any of the tiles above to navigate to:

Economic Impact Jobs & Wages Education & Demographics About the Data

- Economic Impact tab: Provides an overview of the economic contributions, employment statistics, and gross domestic product (GDP) trends for selected industry clusters within Indiana. This tab helps users understand the financial impact of different sectors on the state economy.
- Jobs & Wages tab: Provides detailed information on job roles, wage levels, growth projections, and job postings within the selected industry cluster. This tab is useful for analyzing workforce trends and identifying high-demand, high-growth, and high-wage occupations.
- Education & Demographics tab: Provides insights into the workforce's demographic composition and education requirements within the selected industry cluster. This tab is valuable for understanding diversity, age distribution, gender representation, and the educational qualifications associated with various roles.
- About the Data tab: Provides an overview of the data sources, classifications, and methodologies used to compile and present information within the dashboard. This section helps users understand the origins and limitations of the data, providing context for interpreting the insights available across the dashboard.

Each tab in the dashboard has a set of navigation and functionality buttons at the bottom to help users interact with and customize their view. Here's a guide to each button:



- Undo Button: This button allows you to reverse your last action, such as removing a filter or changing a setting. Use this to quickly backtrack and correct any unintended adjustments.
- Redo Button: This button re-applies the last action that was undone. If you accidentally undo something, click this to restore the previous change.
- Reset View Button: Clicking this button resets the dashboard to its original, default view. It clears any applied filters or changes, providing a fresh start to explore data from the default perspective.
- Download Button: Use this button to download the current view or data from the dashboard. Available formats usually include options like Image, PDF, or PowerPoint, allowing you to save and share insights easily.
 - o Image: Saves the view as a static image.
 - PDF: Downloads the current view as a PDF document.
 - PowerPoint: Exports the view into a PowerPoint slide format for presentations.
- Full-Screen Button: This button expands the dashboard to full screen, providing a larger view for detailed analysis. It's especially useful for presentations or for seeing intricate data visualizations more clearly.
- Share Button: Clicking this button opens options for sharing the dashboard view. You can generate an embed code or a link to share the dashboard with others. Options include:
 - Embed Code: Use this to embed the dashboard in a webpage.
 - Link: Copy a direct link to the dashboard to share via email or messaging.



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Filtering Options



To customize your view, use the following:

- **Industry Cluster:** Select from different industry clusters (e.g., Advanced & Traded) to focus on specific categories.
- **Industry Subcluster:** Choose a subcluster within the selected industry cluster (e.g., Logistics) for a more detailed view. You can clear the subcluster filter by clicking the red X icon next to the filter, which resets it to display data for the entire cluster.



• **Geography**: Select a geographic area, either Indiana statewide or a Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), to view region-specific data.
